# Important notes before proceeding:

Make sure you have **TWO** devices before continuing any further. You will need a separate device besides your phone in this process.

You will be prompted to set up two forms of Multifactor Authentication and must complete both. There are multiple options to select so if you cannot use one of the initial options you may select "I want to set up a different method" at any time.

1. Start by following the steps on your separate device. Not on your phone. Open any browser, i.e. Safari, Chrome, Edge and navigate to *mysignins.microsoft.com*. Then enter your FLCC email address.
