


How to Register for Selective Service

The United States Division of Selective Service has not confirmed your registration or exemption status from registering with them. If you are a male between the ages of 18 and 26, you required to register with Selective Service.

Students who are required to register with the Selective Service must do so to be eligible for Federal Student Aid funds. Until the following requested documentation has been received, your Financial Aid application will be on hold.

Register online using the Selective Service Registration website. You may register online at www.sss.gov if you are a US citizen with a valid social security number. According to the Federal Government, this is the fastest and most reliable way to register.

Confirmation of online registration: You will receive confirmation immediately upon submission. Print and submit the copy of the confirmation to the financial aid office as soon as possible.

Register by mail: You may download the registration form at www.sss.gov/home/registration and mail it to the Selective Service System. This is not the preferred method, as it can take several weeks to receive a confirmation. As previously stated, we will not be able to complete your financial aid award until we receive the confirmation of your registration.

Confirmation of registration by mail: You should receive a letter in the mail within 90 days of registering that proves that you successfully signed up for the Selective Service. If you do not receive this letter after 90 days, call the Selective Service at 1-847-688-6888.
