1. Enrollment in ABE/HSE classes is open to students ages 17 and over who are not currently attending high school and can achieve NRS Level 3 cut - off scores on math and reading pretests. Students who already have their high school diploma may also attend classes for basic skills review which may include upgrading skills for college or preparation for certification testing.
2. When a 17 or 18-year old enrolls, the student will need to submit an official NYS Test Verification Form completed and signed by a high school guidance counselor. Students who are eligible to take the TASC test must meet the NYS testing requirements which include being at least 17 years of age, out of high school for at least one year OR their high school class that has graduated. Students who are under 19 years old and home schooled will also need a verification form. NYSED Verification forms are available from the HSE instructors and at HSE orientation or by calling **(585) 785-1431 or (585) 785-1544. Program requirements also must be met.**
3. Program requirements include that TASC testers be enrolled with enough hours of class time to meet NYSED requirements and also achieve minimum passing scores on a TASC official readiness assessment. **Length of time in classes in order to achieve this varies with each student and depends on skills achieved.**
4. Students who need testing accommodations on the TASC exam must notify the HSE instructor upon enrollment in the class. Special testing can be arranged if appropriate documentation is provided. Since special testing must be pre-approved, extra time is needed to process the application. Approvals are mailed directly to the student who applied.
5. The official test is administered by NYSED at the FLCC TASC Test Center every month. Subject areas are science, social studies, reading, math (algebra, geometry) and writing (including an essay). Tests are times.

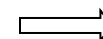


TASC Formerly GED® Prep
