College Community:

The Office of Institutional Effectiveness is pleased to provide the FLCC campus community with the Fall 2014 Enrollment Report.

Overview:

Full-time headcount enrollment is 3317, down 87 students and 2.6% below Fall 2013. Part-time headcount enrollment increased to 3483, up 498 students over Fall 2013, for a 16.7% increase.

The FTE for Fall 2014 is 2148.9, an increase of 24.0 and 1.1% more than Fall 2013.

NOTE: Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) represent a state-wide formula devised for state aid and budgeting purposes. FTE are obtained by dividing the total credit hours taken by students by the constant "30".

Off-campus sites generate 26.7% of all FTE and 12.7% of FTE are produced through on-line offerings.

FLCCs Gemini program accounts for 58.7% of the part-time headcount enrollment and produced a total of 317.3 FTE. In Fall 2014 the Gemini program changed to "tuition free," which contributed to a 46.2% FTE increase over the prior year.

The Report:

The Enrollment Report is organized in 10 sections, A-G provides comparative information over a five year period and H-J compare three years of information.

We welcome your comments and input as we strive to make useful management information available and to make Institutional Effectiveness a valuable partner in the future of FLCC.

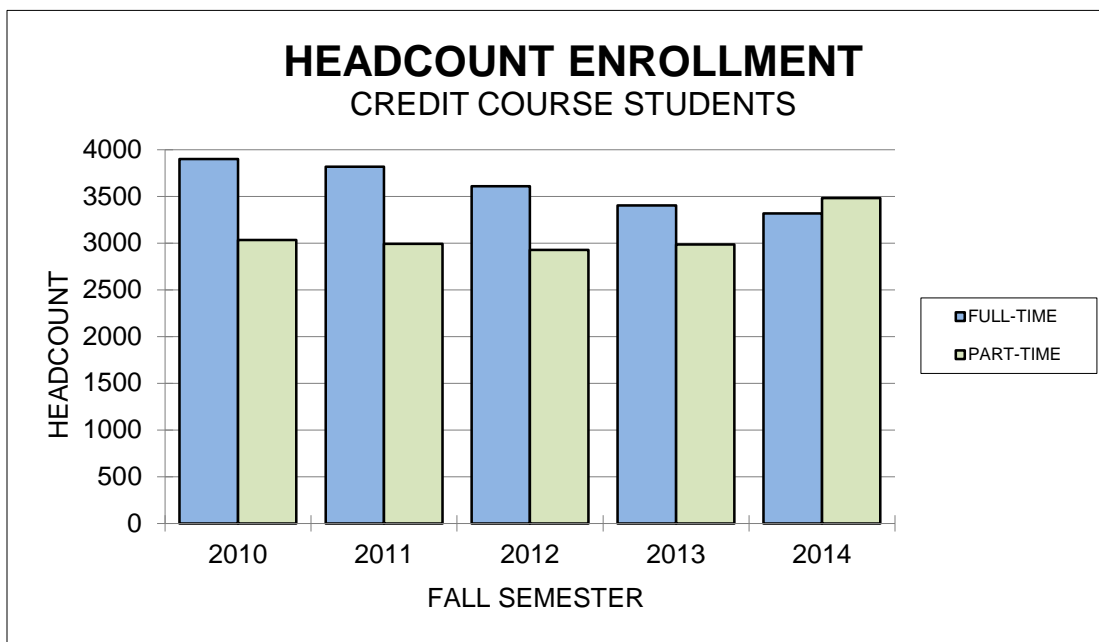

A. Headcount Enrollment

The following chart displays the headcount enrollment of full-time, part-time, and total credit course students from Fall 2010 to Fall 2014:

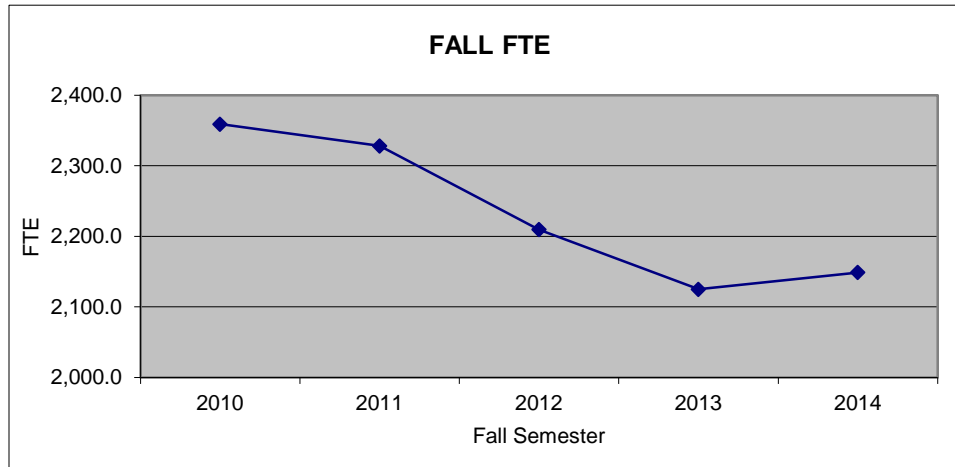
Full-time enrollment in Fall 2014 showed a decrease of 87 students (-2.6%) over Fall 2013 full-time enrollment. Part-time enrollment in Fall 2014 is up 16.7% (498 students) over Fall 2013. Overall, total headcount credit enrollment is up 6.4% from Fall 2013.

(NOTE: Headcount Enrollment figures are based on State Report Data filed with SUNY.)

B. Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Students

In terms of full-time equivalent (FTE) students, there is a 1.1% increase from Fall 2013 to Fall 2014.

Note: FTE enrollment is calculated by dividing by 30 all credit hours taken (for both full-time and part-time students) during a specified reporting period (in this case, Fall semester).

FTE Generated by Location

Fall 2014 day sections on campus produced nearly fifty-four percent (53.6%) of all credit course FTE enrollment. Evening sections on campus produced 7% of the total FTE. Nearly twenty-seven percent (26.7%) of all credit course enrollment is produced at off-campus locations. The on-line course FTE is almost 13% of the total FTE. The following chart displays FTE percent distribution by location from Fall 2010 to Fall 2014.

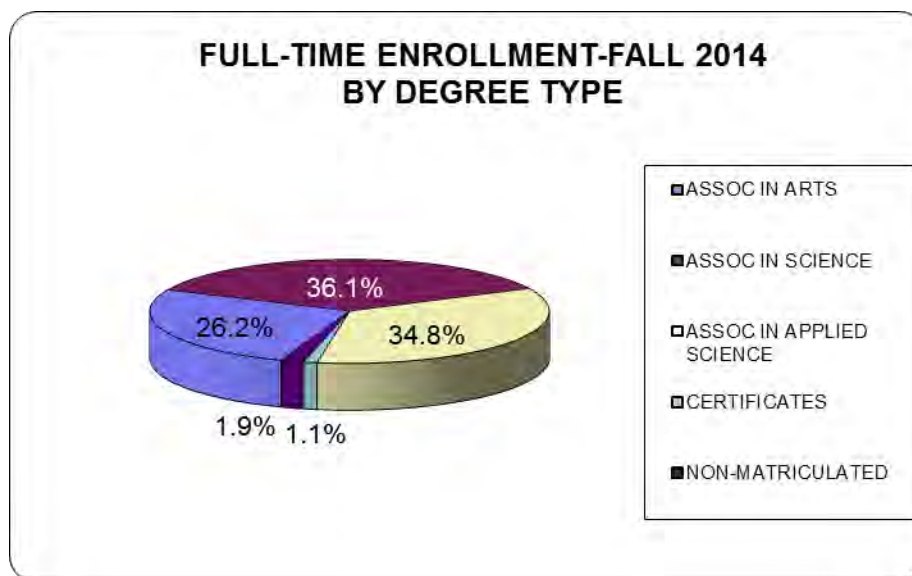

Full-time enrollment in transfer programs (A.A. and A.S.) shows a four-year decrease of 16.7% between Fall 2010 and Fall 2014. Career programs (A.A.S.) full-time enrollment was down overall by 15.1% during this same timeframe.

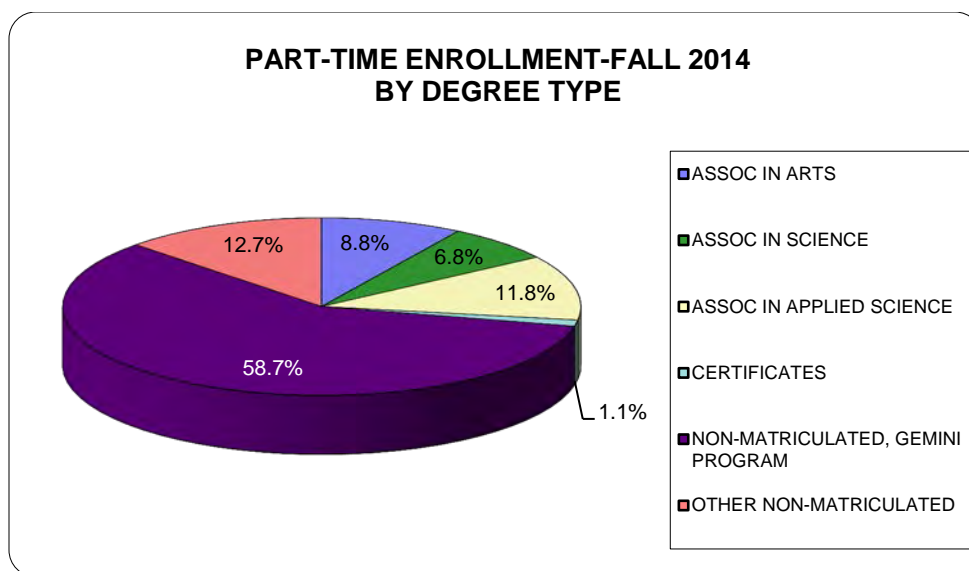

Part-time enrollment in transfer programs (A.A. and A.S.) show a four-year decrease of 8.3% compared to Fall 2010. Part-time enrollment in career programs (A.A.S.) are up overall by 7.0% and non-matriculated enrollment is up 21.7% over this same timeframe.

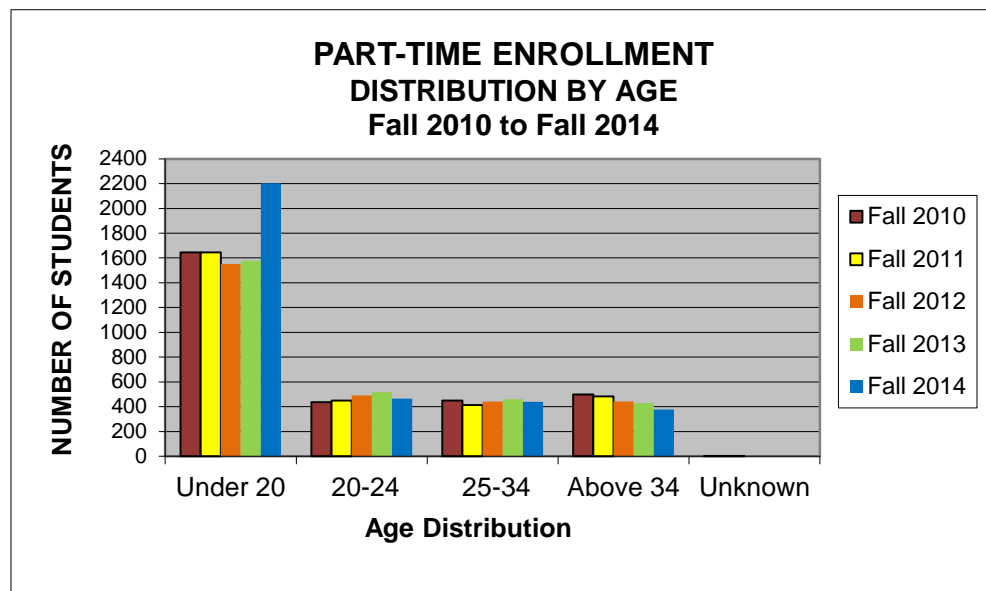
