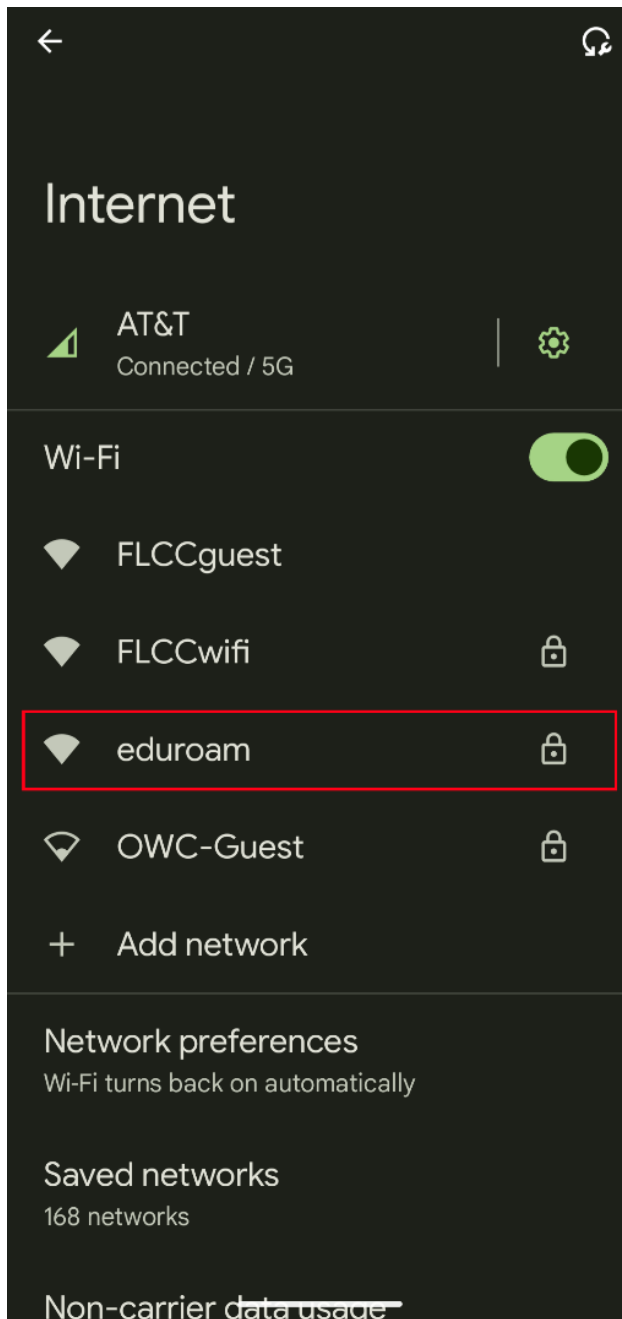


## INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY: CONNECT TO EDUROAM – ANDROID DEVICE


1. Go to the Wi-Fi settings on your Android device and locate **eduroam**. It will look something like the screenshot below.

2. Select **eduroam** and enter in this information:

- EAP method: **PEAP**
- Phase 2 authentication: **MSCHAPV2**
- CA certificate: **Do not verify**
- Domain (is case sensitive): **flcc.edu**

  - Use your FLCC email password and leave **Anonymous identity** empty.
