

1. Go to the Wi-Fi settings on your Android device and locate **eduroam**. It will look something like the screenshot below.





 - Phase 2 authentication: MSCHAPV2
 - CA certificate: Do not verify
 - Domain (is case sensitive): flcc.edu





 - Students: username@fingerlakes.edu (ex: Jdoe2@fingerlakes.edu)
 - Employees: FirstName.LastName@flcc.edu (ex: John.doe@flcc.edu)
 - Use your FLCC email password and leave **Anonymous identity** empty.
