

# Nursing Self-Evaluation Form

**Admission to FLCC's Nursing program is based strictly on a point system.** To calculate the number of points you've earned, follow the instructions below. Each year, up to 800 applications are submitted for the 80-seat Nursing program. Using this worksheet, you will gain a better understanding of the ideal candidate and how you might compare. Courses must be successfully completed by February 1 in order to be considered in the point system.

## Prerequisites that are required for all applicants:

- High school Algebra and Chemistry are prerequisites as well as high school Biology or one semester of college Biology. If a student has not taken Algebra or Chemistry in high school, CHM 092 Introduction to Chemistry and MAT 095 Fundamental Mathematics and Algebra Skills must be successfully completed prior to your first semester in the Nursing program.
- All applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 or better (or a 2.0 for those with a bachelor's degree) and have received a grade of C or better in all Nursing prerequisite coursework. In addition, grades of I, Q, W in any "point earning course"\* must be repeated successfully prior to being considered for admission.

\* See Point Key 1 and Point Key 2 below for details regarding point earning courses.

**Step 1:** If you have taken the courses listed in the chart below, use Point Key 1 to determine the number of points earned based on your grades. Also, be sure to factor in possible point reductions, if applicable.

BIO 171 Human Anatomy & Physiology I, BIO 172 Human Anatomy & Physiology II, and BIO 230 Microbiology must be taken within ten years of matriculation into the Nursing program.

**Point Reductions:** If you repeated BIO 171 Human Anatomy & Physiology I or BIO 172 Human Anatomy & Physiology II because of an unsuccessful completion (that is, you earned a grade below a C or you earned an I, Q, W or MW\*), DEDUCT HALF THE POINTS for the repeated course. If you have two unsuccessful completions of either of these courses, you will receive 0 points for the repeated course. Also, if you have taken BIO 171 twice and already received a 1/2 point reduction, or if you need to repeat BIO 172, you will receive 0 points for the repeated course.

\* Any grade of MW (Medical Withdrawal) received from FLCC or any other accredited institution of higher learning awarded before August 31, 2015 will be grandfathered in and will not count against a student applying for the Nursing program. After August 31, 2015, the first MW received for a course will have no impact on the application process; however, any subsequent MWs for the same course will be treated as Ws in the application process. Multiple MWs in more than one semester will require an administrative review for approval.

**Step 2:** If you have taken the courses listed in the chart below, use Point Key 2 to determine the number of points earned based on your grades. Please note, if you have taken BIO 110 Fundamentals of Human Anatomy & Physiology in addition to BIO 171 Human Anatomy & Physiology I, points will only be awarded for BIO 171.

**Point Reductions:** If you repeated ENG 101, PSY 100, PSY 200, or BIO 110 because of an unsuccessful completion (that is, you earned a grade below a C or you earned an I, Q, W or MW\*), DEDUCT HALF THE POINTS for the repeated course. If you have two unsuccessful completions of any of these courses, you will receive 0 points for the repeated course.

\* Any grade of MW (Medical Withdrawal) received from FLCC or any other accredited institution of higher learning awarded before August 31, 2015 will be grandfathered in and will not count against a student applying for the Nursing program. After August 31, 2015, the first MW received for a course will have no impact on the application process; however, any subsequent MWs for the same course will be treated as Ws in the application process. Multiple MWs in more than one semester will require an administrative review for approval.

**The maximum number of points that can be earned is 90.** The more points you have earned, the better chance you have of being admitted. The average number of points earned by accepted students varies year to year based on the applicant pool.
