

2019 Nursing Applicant Information and Self-Evaluation Form

Admission to FLCC's Nursing program is based strictly on a point system. The more points you have earned, the better chance you have of being admitted. The average number of points earned by accepted students varies year to year based on the applicant pool. While students may qualify for review upon completion of the prerequisites, applicants with the strongest academic credentials will have the greatest chance of admission. The 80 individuals with the highest number of points will be accepted into the Nursing program.

To calculate the number of points you've earned, follow the instructions below. By completing this worksheet, you will gain a better understanding of the ideal candidate and how you might compare. Courses must be successfully completed and TEAS scores received by February 1 for consideration

Step 1: Once you have taken the Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) exam calculate the points you have earned based on your score.

Step 2: Calculate your Admission Bonus Points

If you have taken any of the Bonus Point Courses listed in the following table, or live in the service area, or are a veteran, or have earned a BS degree with a final GPA of 2.0 or higher you qualify for Admission Bonus Points.

Admission Bonus Point Award Rules:

If you have taken BIO110 Fundamentals of Human Anatomy & Physiology or AP BIO (Advanced Placement) and BIO171 Human Anatomy & Physiology I, points will only be awarded for BIO171.

If you have passed with a grade of C or better BIO171 Anatomy & Physiology I, BIO172 Anatomy and Physiology II, HCS153 Career Opportunities in Health Care or HCS154 Medical Terminology and repeat the course and earn a B- or better on the second attempt, FULL point value will be awarded.

If you have 1 unsatisfactory completion of BIO171 Anatomy & Physiology I, BIO172 Anatomy and Physiology II, HCS153 Career Opportunities in Health Care or HCS154 Medical Terminology (i.e. C- or below, I, NA, or W), and repeat the course and earn a B- or better on the second attempt, a reduction of ½ the point value will be awarded.

If you have two unsuccessful completions of BIO171 Anatomy & Physiology I, BIO172 Anatomy and Physiology II, HCS153 Career Opportunities in Health Care or HCS154 Medical Terminology (i.e. C- or below, I, NA, or W), and you successfully repeat the course and earn a B- on the third attempt you will earn 0 points for the repeated course.

If you passed the Aspiring Nurses Roundtable, and then later took HCS153 Career Opportunities in Health Care, the grade in HCS153 will be the grade to which the point rules will apply.

CONTINUED ON REVERSE

Any grade of MW (Medical Withdrawal) received from FLCC or any other accredited institution of higher learning awarded before August 31, 2015 will be grandfathered in and will not count against a student applying for the Nursing program. After August 31, 2015, the first MW received for a course will have no impact on the application process; however, any subsequent MWs for the same course will be treated as Ws in the application process. Multiple MWs in more than one semester will require an administrative review for approval.
