

Policy Statement

Finger Lakes Community College will comply with New York State Education Law and applicable regulations of the New York State Education Department that specify approvals required for the establishment and structural modification of community college divisions, departments, administrative positions and academic positions, and the specification of the duties of such units and positions.

Proposals for creation of new divisions, departments, administrative positions and academic positions, the modification of existing divisions, departments and positions, and/or the specification of the duties of such units and positions shall be submitted through the College's strategic planning process or to the employee's division or department head.

The College President shall recommend to the FLCC Board of Trustees proposals regarding new divisions, departments and administrative and academic positions as s/he deems advisable. The FLCC Board of Trustees shall have ultimate authority for approving or rejecting the recommendations.

Reason for Policy

This policy is intended to ensure that proposals for reorganization involving such matters are approved in a manner consistent with applicable regulatory requirements.

Applicability of the Policy

All College employees involved in the strategic and organizational planning process should be familiar with this policy.
